Senator **Karen Mayne** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 8, Lines 215 through 220a:

- 215 (1) [~~The university~~] In consultation with the director appointed under Section  
216 53B-30-205, the president of the University of Utah and the president of Weber State  
217 University, or the presidents' designees, shall create an advisory board known as the "Rocky  
218 Mountain Center for Occupational and Environmental Health Advisory Board" to:  
219 (a) promote occupational health and safety in Utah and the surrounding region; ~~§~~→  
219a (b) promote the development of undergraduate training in occupational health and  
219b safety;  
219c (c) engage other higher education institutions in the state to participate in improving  
219d occupational health and safety education and programs for undergraduate students and other
