MEDICAL RECORDS AMENDMENTS

Senator **Karen Mayne** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Line 54:*

54 (i) [~~\$21.16~~] \$30 per request for locating a patient's records[~~, per request~~];

2. *Page 3, Lines 74 through 80:*

74 (iv) if requested, the health care provider or the health care provider's contracted third party
75 service will certify the record as a duplicate of the

76 original for a fee of \$20; and

76 [(iv)] (v) any sales tax owed under Title 59, Chapter 12, Sales and Use Tax Act.

77 (6) A health care provider or [its] ~~{a}~~ the health care provider's contracted third party service

78 shall deliver the medical records in the [~~digital or~~] electronic medium customarily used by the

119 (7)(c)(ii)(B).

(c) On or before January 30, 2022, and on or before January 30 of each year thereafter, the state
treasurer shall:

(i) certify the inflation-adjusted fees and maximum amounts calculated under this section; and

(ii) notify the Administrative Office of the Courts of the information described in Subsection (8)(c)(i)
for posting on the court's website.
