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28	WHEREAS, the Utah State Board of Education has the statutory responsibility to
29	establish rules and minimum standards for the public schools, including curriculum and
30	instruction requirements:
31	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives strongly
32	recommends that the Utah State Board of Education review standards for curriculum and
33	ensure that $\hat{H} \Rightarrow [no \text{ curriculum or instructional materials in the state include}] \leftarrow \hat{H}$ the following
33a	concepts $\hat{H} \rightarrow \underline{\text{are not included in the curriculum standards}} \leftarrow \hat{H}$:
34	 that one race is inherently superior or inferior to another race;
35	 that an individual should be discriminated against or receive adverse treatment
36	because of the individual's race; or
37	that an individual's moral character is determined by the individual's race.
38	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the House of Representatives strongly recommends
39	that no training or training material that the Utah State Board of Education or a local education
40	agency provides include the concepts described in $\hat{\mathbf{H}} \rightarrow [\text{this resolution}]$ the preceding
40a	<u>paragraph</u> ←Ĥ .
41	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Utah State Board of Education report back to
42	the Education Interim Committee regarding the board's progress related to this resolution.
