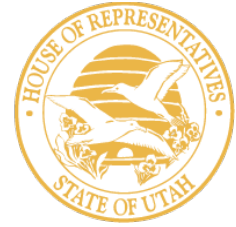

## UTAH STATE LEGISLATURE CALL OF LEGISLATIVE VETO OVERRIDE SESSION

Pursuant to Article VII, Section 8 of the Utah Constitution and Utah State Legislative Joint Rule Title Two, Chapter Two, its presiding officers, the Honorable J. Stuart Adams, President of the Utah Senate, and the Honorable Brad R. Wilson, Speaker of the Utah House of Representatives, have polled the members of the Senate and the House of Representatives, and do hereby call the 64<sup>th</sup> Utah State Legislature into a Legislative Veto Override Session to convene at the State Capitol on Friday, March 25, 2022 at 1:00 p.m.


At least two-thirds of the members of each house voted in favor of convening a Veto Override Session. Governor Spencer J. Cox vetoed the following bills or items of appropriation passed by the Legislature which adjourned on March 4, 2022:

H.B. 11 Fourth Substitute -- Student Eligibility in Interscholastic Activities (Rep. Birkeland, K.)

The Utah State Legislature may address any additional vetoed bills or vetoed items of appropriation from the 2022 General Session.
