8 **LONG TITLE**

9 **Committee Note:**

10 The Health and Human Services Interim Committee recommended this bill.

11 Legislative Vote: 13 voting for 0 voting against 5 absent

12 **General Description:**

13 This bill repeals the sunset date for provisions related to the study of long-term needs
14 for adult beds in the state hospital.

15 **Highlighted Provisions:**

16 This bill:

17 ▶ repeals the sunset date for provisions requiring the Forensic Mental Health
18 Coordinating Council, in consultation with the Utah Substance Use and Mental
19 Health Advisory Council, to study the long-term needs for adult beds in the state
20 hospital; and

21 ▶ makes technical and conforming changes.
