247 Section 4. Section **19-6-807** is amended to read:

248 **19-6-807. Waste Tire Recycling Fund.**

249 (1) There is created an expendable special revenue fund entitled the "Waste Tire  
250 Recycling Fund."

251 (2) The fund shall consist of:

252 (a) the proceeds of [the] ~~H~~→ :

252a (i) ←H a fee imposed under Section 19-6-805 H→ [or] ; and

252b (ii) a fee imposed under Section ←H 19-6-806; and

253 (b) penalties collected under this part.

254 (3) Money in the fund shall be used for:

255 (a) partial reimbursement of the costs of transporting, processing, recycling, or  
256 disposing of waste tires as provided in this part; and

257 (b) payment of administrative costs of local health departments as provided in Section  
258 19-6-817.

259 (4) The Legislature may appropriate money from the fund to pay for:

260 (a) the costs of the Department of Environmental Quality in administering and  
261 enforcing this part; and

262 (b) other operational costs of the Department of Environmental Quality, if the  
263 Legislature estimates there is a deficit in the Department of Environmental Quality's budget for  
264 the current or next fiscal year.

265 Section 5. **Effective date.**

266 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2022.
