**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill requires a portion of a peace officer's ~~H→~~ **[annual] basic** ~~←H~~ training to include certain subjects involving victim targeting.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:  
▶ defines terms;  
▶ requires ~~H→~~ **under certain conditions** ~~←H~~ a peace officer's ~~H→~~ **[annual] basic** ~~←H~~ training to include training on identifying, responding to, and reporting a criminal offense that is motivated by certain personal attributes or a violation of federal criminal law concerning hate crimes; and  
▶ makes technical and conforming changes.

Section 1. Section **53-6-202** is amended to read:
