LONG TITLE

7 **General Description:**

8 This bill amends provisions related to state vehicle use and purchasing.

9 **Highlighted Provisions:**

10 This bill:

11 ▶ directs the Division of Fleet Operations (division) to annually review the use of
12 state vehicles;

13 ▶ when prudent, requires the division to replace a state vehicle with a low or zero
14 emissions vehicle; and

15 ▶ prioritizes certain low or zero emissions vehicles to replace state vehicles.

22 **63A-9-403**, as enacted by Laws of Utah 2014, Chapter 190

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

24 Section 1. Section **63A-9-403** is repealed and reenacted to read:

25 **63A-9-403.** **Review of state vehicle use -- Replacement.**



- 28 (1) The division shall annually review the use of all state vehicles to:
29 (a) reallocate underutilized state vehicles;
30 (b) remove unnecessary state vehicles; and
31 (c) assign new or replacement state vehicles to an agency.
32 (2) In consultation with the agency using the state vehicle, the division shall, when
33 prudent, replace a state vehicle with one of the following low or zero emissions vehicles, in the
34 following order of priority:
35 (a) a fully ~~H~~→ **battery or fuel cell** ←~~H~~ electric vehicle;
36 (b) a plug-in hybrid vehicle;
37 (c) any other alternative fuel vehicle; or
38 (d) the most reasonable traditional fuel vehicle available.
