8 **LONG TITLE**

9 **General Description:**

10 This bill repeals the sunset date for provisions related to the study of long-term needs
11 for adult beds in the state hospital.

12 **Highlighted Provisions:**

13 This bill:

14 ▶ repeals the sunset date for provisions requiring the Forensic Mental Health
15 Coordinating Council, in consultation with the Utah Substance Use and Mental
16 Health Advisory Council, to study the long-term needs for adult beds in the state
17 hospital; and

18 ▶ makes technical and conforming changes.

25 **63I-1-262**, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2021, Chapters 29 and 91

27 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

28 Section 1. Section **63I-1-262** is amended to read:

29 **63I-1-262. Repeal dates, Title 62A.**

33 Coordinating Council for Persons with Disabilities, are repealed July 1, 2022.

37 repealed January 1, 2023.

42 Council, is repealed July 1, 2023.

44 Substance Use and Mental Health Advisory Council, are repealed January 1, 2023.
- 45 [(10)] (9) In relation to the Behavioral Health Crisis Response Commission, on July 1,
46 2023:

- 48 (b) Subsection 62A-15-1302(1)(b), the language that states "and in consultation with
49 the commission" is repealed;

51 commission," is repealed;

53 from the commission," is repealed; and
