	Section 1. Section 23-13-20 is enacted to read:	
	23-13-20. Wildlife Conservation Fund.	
	(1) As used in this section:	
	(a) "Fund" means the Wildlife Conservation Fund created by this section.	
	(b) "Wildlife conservation permit program" means a program under which the division	
iss	sues permit opportunities to be sold by a conservation organization for auction to the highest	

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30	bidder at a fund-raising event.	
31	(c) "Wildlife exposition program" means a program under which the division allocates	
32	permits to a drawing administered by a selected conservation organization as part of a regional	
33	or national exposition for the purpose of generating revenue to fund wildlife conservation	
34	activities in Utah.	
35	(2) There is created an expendable special revenue fund known as the "Wildlife	
36	Conservation Fund."	
37	(3) The fund consists of:	
38	(a) wildlife conservation permit program revenue transferred to the division pursuant to	
39	rules, made by the Wildlife Board in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
