2728	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
29	Section 1. Section 19-4-115 is enacted to read:
30	19-4-115. Drinking Water Capacity Account.
31	(1) As used in this section:
32	(a) "Account" means the Drinking Water Capacity Account created in this section.
33	(b) "Equivalent residential connection" means a measure of the impact on a public
34	facility that is equal to the impact of one typical single-family detached dwelling unit.
35	(c) "Retail" means the level of distribution of water that supplies water directly to the
36	end user.
37	(2) There is created a restricted account in the General Fund known as the "Drinking
38	Water Capacity Account."
39	(3) (a) The account consists of:
40	(i) revenue generated under Subsection (5);
41	(ii) appropriations of the Legislature; and
42	(iii) interest and earnings earned on the account.
43	(b) The Office of the Treasurer shall deposit interest and other earnings derived from
44	investment of money in the account into the account.
45	(4) Subject to appropriation by the Legislature, the division may use the money in the
46	account to implement this chapter, including to:
47	(a) assist a public water system in meeting drinking water standards;
48	(b) provide direct technical assistance and training to a public water system;
49	(c) assist a public water system in planning for and serving future growth; and
50	(d) review an application for a new public water system, expansion of a public water
51	system, or upgrade of a public water system.
52	(5) (a) In accordance with Section 63J-1-504 and subject to Subsection (5)(b), the
53	division shall, for the purposes described in Subsection (4), impose and collect an annual fee
54	on retail water provided by a public water system.
55	(b) The division shall determine the annual fee imposed under this Subsection (5) on
56	the basis of equivalent residential connections, except that the fee each year may not exceed the

57	greater of:
58	(i) \$1.20 per equivalent residential connection served by the public water system; or
59	(ii) a minimum of \$25.
60	(c) The division shall deposit money from the fee imposed under this Subsection (5)
61	into the account.
62	Section 2. Appropriation.
63	The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
64	2022, and ending June 30, 2023. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for
65	fiscal year 2023. Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures
66	Act, the Legislature appropriates the following sums of money from the funds or accounts
67	indicated for the use and support of the government of the state of Utah.
