#### **LONG TITLE**

#### **General Description:**

This bill requires certain {recyclers} recyclable material haulers to publish information about the end location of recyclable materials.

#### **Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

- defines terms; and
- requires a <a href="recyclable material hauler">\text{recycler}\recyclable material hauler</a> who bills customers through a political subdivision's billing and collection system to <a href="publish">\text{publish}\recyclable</a>, to the <a href="political subdivision">\text{political subdivision</a>, data about the end location of recyclable materials collected by the <a href="recyclable material hauler">\text{recycler}\recyclable</a> material hauler; and
- requires a political subdivision to publish the recycling data in a newsletter and, if available, on the political subdivision's website.

19-6-509, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section 19-6-509 is enacted to read:

**19-6-509.** Recycling data.

- (1) As used in this section:
- (a) "Municipal solid waste" means nonhazardous solid waste, including garbage, refuse, office waste, or other similar material that results from the operation of residential, municipal, commercial, or institutional establishments or community activities.
  - (b) "Recyclable material" means municipal solid waste that is suitable for recycling.
- (c) "{Recycle" means to take action to recover recyclable materials from the municipal solid waste stream for the purposes of use or reuse, conversion into raw materials, or use in the production of new products.
- (d) "Recycler" means the owner or operator of a facility, including a facility that is owned by Recyclable material hauler" means a person, including a political subdivision, {that}who:
  - (i) {recycles} for compensation, collects and transports recyclable material; and
- (ii) uses the billing and collection system of a political subdivision to bill or collect payment from the {recycler's} recyclable material hauler's customers.
- ({2) A recycler shall publish}d) "Recycle" means to take action to recover recyclable materials from the municipal solid waste stream for the purposes of use or reuse, conversion into raw materials, or use in the production of new products.
- (2) A recyclable material hauler shall report, in accordance with Subsection (3) and according to the best of the recycler's knowledge :
  - (a) by category, the approximate tonnage of recyclable material collected by the

(i) disposed in a landfill;
(ii) used for energy production;
(iii) recycled; and
(iv) transported out of the country; and
(b) the approximate tonnage of recyclable material hauler that the recyclable material
{collected by the recycler that had an end location or was disposed of in a way other than a way
described in Subsection (2)(a).
(3) (a) A recycler shall publish}hauler delivered to:
(a) a landfill; and
(b) a recycling facility.
(3) (a) At least two times each calendar year, a recyclable material hauler shall provide
the information described in Subsection (2) {at least two times each calendar year:
(i) as an insert with or attachment to the bill that is sent to the recycler's customers; and
(ii) if the recycler maintains a publicly accessible website, on that website.
(b) A recycler's publication of information under this section shall include the required
data}to the political subdivision whose billing and collection system the recyclable material
<u>hauler uses.</u>
(b) The recyclable material hauler shall provide data under Subsection (3)(a) for the
longer of:
(i) the time since the {recycler}recyclable material hauler last {published}provided the
data; or
(ii) six months before the {date of the publication.
day on which the data is provided.
(4) Within 45 days after the day on which a recyclable material hauler provides data
under this section, a political subdivision shall publish the data, as available:
(a) in a newsletter produced by the municipality; and
(b) on a website operated by the municipality.
