26	(1) If a criminal prosecution has been instituted against [such person] a defendant
27	under the laws of this state and is still pending, the governor[, in his discretion,] may either

surrender [him] the defendant on demand of the executive authority of another state or hold
[him until he] the defendant until the defendant has been tried and [discharged or] either
convicted and [punished] sentenced, or acquitted in this state.
(2) The period of time for extradition shall be tolled when local charges are pending in
this state. The defendant's waiver is unenforceable until the defendant is timely tried and either
convicted and sentenced, or acquitted in this state.
