19	of portland limestone cement in state construction projects.

23	Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
24	WHEREAS, blended cements are innovative and proven products;
25	WHEREAS, portland cement is an industry term for the most commonly used cement

WHEREAS, portland limestone is an industry term for blended cement that consists of

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that contains up to 5% crushed limestone;

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28	between 5% and 15% crushed limestone, which is an abundant natural resource in the state of
29	Utah;
30	WHEREAS, blended cements are used to reduce CO2 and enhance durability;
31	WHEREAS, blended cements have been developed and used effectively in other states
32	for many years as a suitable alternative for traditional cement;
33	WHEREAS, the development of portland limestone cement is known to result in fewer
34	carbon dioxide emissions than the production of traditional cement;
35	WHEREAS, Utah is an important cement producing state in the country;
36	WHEREAS, Utah has a responsibility to conduct Utah's work in a manner that will
37	incentivize the production and use of products known to have environmental benefits;
38	WHEREAS, federal policies are expected to continue prioritizing emission reduction
39	and sustainability with specific regard to publicly funded projects;
40	WHEREAS, Utah's economic development is among the most robust in the nation and
41	the demand for new construction is high;
42	WHEREAS, for the reasons described in this resolution, it is in the best interest of all
43	parties engaged in the construction of state projects to begin a methodical transition toward the
44	incorporation of portland limestone cement and other blended cements; and
45	WHEREAS, the Department of Government Operations and Department of
46	Transportation may within their discretion enact or take measures that will result in the use of
47	blended cements in state projects:
48	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah,
49	encourages the Department of Government Operations and the Department of Transportation to
50	review the benefits of blended cements and adopt standards to incentivize its use in state
51	building projects, roads, and bridges, with a target date of October 1, 2022, to begin a
52	methodical transition to the incorporation of portland limestone cement in state construction
53	projects.

55	director of the Department of Government Operations and the executive director of the
56	Department of Transportation.
