8 **General Description:**

9 This bill amends the Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act.

10 **Highlighted Provisions:**

11 This bill:

- 12 ▶ requires that rules be consistent with, and designed to fulfill, state statute; and
- 13 ▶ provides that a rule that is inconsistent with, or contrary to, state statute is void and
- 14 unenforceable.

23 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

24 Section 1. Section **63G-3-103** is enacted to read:

25 **63G-3-103. Supremacy of state statute over rules.**

26 (1) Legislative rules shall be consistent with, and fulfill the direction given in, state

27 statute.



28 (2) A rule that is inconsistent with, or contrary to, state statute is void and
29 unenforceable.
