28	(a) (i) "Applied behavior analysis" means the design, implementation, and evaluation
29	of environmental modifications, using behavioral stimuli and consequences, to produce
30	socially significant improvement in human behavior.
31	(ii) "Applied behavior analysis" includes the use of direct observation, measurement,
32	and functional analysis of the relationship between environment and behavior.
33	(b) "Autism spectrum disorder" means pervasive developmental disorders as defined
34	by the most recent edition of the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders.

37	(i) necessary to develop, maintain, or restore, to the maximum extent practicable, the

41	(B) an individual licensed under Title 58, Occupations and Professions, whose scope of

43	(d) "Diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder" means medically necessary assessments,

46	(A) a licensed physician who is board certified in neurology, psychiatry, or pediatrics
