	(1) As used in this rule, "legislative assistant" means an employee hired by the
presi	ident whose job responsibilities include:
	(a) making copies, compiling documents, scheduling meetings, and other clerical and
adm	inistrative tasks;

28	(b) creating informational materials, talking points, and correspondence;
29	(c) responding to a senator's constituents' requests for information;
30	(d) managing a senator's schedule;
31	(e) planning and coordinating legislative district events;
32	(f) coordinating with professional staff regarding a senator's legislation, research
33	requests, and requests for appropriations; and
34	(g) assisting with the development of a senator's legislative and budgetary priorities.
35	(2) Unless the senator declines, the president shall assign one legislative assistant to
