The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 23**, FIRST RESPONDER MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AMENDMENTS, by Representative R. D. Wilcox, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Line 51 through Page 3, Line 64:*

- 51 (3) "First responder" means:
- 52 (a) a law enforcement officer, as defined in Section 53-13-103;
- * * * Some lines not shown * * *
- 62 (j) a credentialed criminal justice system victim advocate as defined in Section
- 63 77-38-403 who responds to incidents with a law enforcement officer; {~~or~~} .
- 64 (k) a crime scene investigator technician ; or
- (l) a wildland firefighter .

2. *Page 5, Lines 132 through 133:*

- 132 (7) The department may adopt rules in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
- 133 Administrative Rulemaking Act to {~~.~~} :
- (a) set parameters for services for retirees; and
- (b) administer this chapter.
