The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 86**, PARENTING PLAN AMENDMENTS, by Representative C. Spackman Moss, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 45 through 50:*

- 45 (3) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (3)(b) and except for a temporary
restraining
46 order under Rule 65A of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, if a party files a petition to
modify
47 ~~{ a parenting plan, the court may not grant the motion }~~ under Subsection
(2) that may result in modification of a parenting plan, the court may not grant the
petition to modify until both parties have:
48 (i) attended the mandatory educational course described in Section 30-3-11.5; and
49 (ii) presented a certificate of completion for the mandatory educational course to the
50 court.
