Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 113**, FUNDING FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES, by Representative M. Judkins, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Line 57 through Page 3, Line 67:*

- 57 (i) The special education student growth factor is calculated by comparing [S-3]  
total  
58 special education [ADM of two years] average daily membership of one year previous to  
the  
59 current year to the [S-3] total special education [ADM three] average daily membership  
two  
60 years previous to the current year, not to exceed the official October total school district  
{or  
61 charter school} growth factor from the prior year.  
62 (ii) When calculating and applying the growth factor, a school district's [S-3] {  
or charter  
63 school's} total special education [ADM] average daily membership for a given year is  
limited to  
64 [~~12-18%~~] the following percentage of the school district's [S-3] {or charter school's  
-} total student  
65 [ADM] average daily membership for the same year[-]:  
66 (A) for a school district {or charter school} in a county of the first, second,  
or third class,
