The Economic Development and Workforce Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 213**, DISABLED PARKING PERMIT AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. D. Stenquist, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 73 through 78:*

73 (13) In IBC, the following is added below Table 1106.1: "Where two or more
