Mr. President,

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 293**,
GROUND AMBULANCE INTERFACILITY TRANSPORT LICENSING, by Representative R.
D. Wilcox, with the following amendments:

1. Page 8, Line 242 through Page 9, Line 246:

- 242 (3) The department may, without an adjudicative proceeding but with at least 30
days notice to providers in the same geographic service area, amend an existing

243 ambulance interfacility transport license { ~~that creates a new~~ } solely to convert
an overlay into an overlap if the existing ground

(4) An amendment of a license under this section may not alter:
(a) other terms of the original license, including the applicable geographic service
area; or
(b) the license of other providers that provide interfacility transport services in
the geographic service area.
