Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 396**, PAID PROFESSIONAL HOURS FOR EDUCATORS, by Representative J. Moss, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Line 45 through 48:*

45       (3) An LEA shall use funding under this section to provide paid professional  
= hours ~~{in professional~~  
46 development} that:  
47       (a) ~~{provides}~~ provide educators with the knowledge and skills  
necessary to enable students to  
48 succeed in a well-rounded education and to meet the challenging state academic  
standards; and

2. *Page 3, Line 64 through 66:*

64       (v) are aligned with, and directly related to, academic goals of the school or LEA;  
and  
65       (vi) include instruction in the use of data and assessments to inform and instruct  
66 classroom practice.

**(4) An educator shall:**  
**(a) before the first day of instruction in a given school year, create a plan, in**  
**consultation with the educator's principal, on how the educator plans to use paid**  
**professional hours provided under this section during the school year; and**  
**(b) before the end of a given school year, provide a written statement to the**  
**educator's principal of how the educator used paid professional hours provided**  
**under this section during the school year.**
