Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 396**, PAID PROFESSIONAL HOURS FOR EDUCATORS, by Representative J. Moss, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 45 through 48:
  - 45 (3) An LEA shall use funding under this section to provide paid professional hours { in professional
  - 46 development that:
  - 47 (a) { provides } provide educators with the knowledge and skills necessary to enable students to
  - 48 <u>succeed in a well-rounded education and to meet the challenging state academic standards; and</u>
- 2. Page 3, Line 64 through 66:
  - 64 (v) are aligned with, and directly related to, academic goals of the school or LEA; and
  - 65 (vi) include instruction in the use of data and assessments to inform and instruct
  - 66 <u>classroom practice.</u>
    - (4) An educator shall:
    - (a) before the first day of instruction in a given school year, create a plan, in consultation with the educator's principal, on how the educator plans to use paid professional hours provided under this section during the school year; and
    - (b) before the end of a given school year, provide a written statement to the educator's principal of how the educator used paid professional hours provided under this section during the school year.







## 3. Page 4, Line 101 through 105:

- 101 (6) In preparing budget bills for a given fiscal year, the Executive Appropriations
- 102 Committee shall make the one-time appropriations described in Subsection (3)(a) by
- appropriating the lesser of 10% of the total amount of the one-time appropriations or the cost of
- 104 <u>providing 32 <u>paid</u> <u>professional</u> { <u>development</u> } <u>hours for teachers in accordance with Section</u></u>
- 105 <u>53F-7-202.</u>
