Mr. Speaker,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 441**, COMMUNITY PARAMEDICINE AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. N. Johnson, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 6, Lines 165 through 168:*

165 (b) A community paramedicine program shall report data, as determined by the
166 committee, related to community paramedicine to the department.

(3) A service provided as part of a community paramedicine program may not be billed to an individual or a health benefit plan as defined in Section 31A-1-301 unless:

(a) the service is provided in partnership with a health care facility as defined in Section 26-21-2; and

(b) the partnering health care facility is the person that bills the individual or health benefit plan.

(4) Nothing in this section affects any billing authorized under Section 26-8a-403.

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167 ~~{(3)}~~ **(5)** In accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative
 Rulemaking Act, the
168 committee shall make rules to implement this section.
