The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on H.C.R. 18, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION HIGHLIGHTING THE IMPORTANCE OF SUPPORTIVE NETWORKS OF ADULTS FOR CHILD SUCCESS AND OPPORTUNITY, by Representative E. Weight, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 21 through 22:
 - 21 organizations who make up supportive networks of adults and diminish the harmful
 - 22 effects of adverse childhood experiences (ACEs); and
- 2. Page 2, Line 38:
 - 38 and adverse childhood experiences <u>(ACEs)</u>, including abuse, neglect, substance use or mental illness in
- 3. Page 2, Lines 40 through 42:
 - 40 WHEREAS, a supportive network of adults reinforces to a child that the child is strong $\{-,-\}$ and
 - 41 capable { , } and { necessary and assist } <u>possesses value and assists</u> the child to build social and emotional skills necessary for
 - 42 **successful** development;
- 4. Page 3, Lines 59 through 61:
 - 59 participating in, and building supportive networks of adults that provide acknowledgment and
 - 60 encouragement to children and create opportunities for all Utah's children to reach full
