Mr. Speaker,

The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. S.B. 66**, ELECTRIC ASSISTED BICYCLE USE AMENDMENTS, by Senator T. D. Weiler, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 14, Lines 411 through 418:
  - 411 specific classification of an electric assisted bicycle, on a sidewalk, path, or trail within the
  - 412 jurisdiction of the local authority or state agency.
  - 413 (b) (i) {A} Subject to Subsection (3)(b)(ii), a local authority, political subdivision, or state agency may not adopt an ordinance
  - 414 or rule to regulate or restrict an individual with a mobility disability from using an electric
  - 415 <u>assisted bicycle or an adaptive electric assisted bicycle on a sidewalk, path, or trail within</u> <u>the</u>
  - 416 jurisdiction of the local authority or state agency.

<u>(ii) (A) A local authority, political subdivision, or state agency may impose</u> <u>legitimate and reasonable safety requirements necessary for the safe operation of</u> <u>services, programs, or activities related to the use of an electric assisted bicycle or an</u> <u>adaptive electric assisted bicycle.</u>

<u>(B) A local authority, political subdivision, or state agency shall ensure that a</u> <u>safety requirement imposed pursuant to Subsection (3)(b)(ii)(A) is based on actual</u> <u>risks, and not mere speculation, stereotypes, or generalizations about individuals</u> <u>with a mobility disability.</u>

- 417 (4) An individual under 16 years [of age] old may not operate a class 3 electric assisted
- 418 bicycle.
