## NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 1, 2022

Mr. Speaker,

The Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee has returned **S.B. 88**, DIGITAL DRIVER LICENSE AMENDMENTS, by Senator L. Fillmore to the Rules Committee and with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 13 through 15:
  - 13 defines terms;
    14 makes the electronic license certificate and identification card program { permanent } <u>a permanent option</u>;
    15 requires the division to maintain the security and privacy of information related to
- 2. Page 9, Line 256 through 258:
  - 256 (1) On or before January 1, 2022, the division shall establish <u>and maintain</u> a process
  - 257 and system for an individual <u>to have the option</u> to obtain an electronic license certificate or identification card.
