Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 101**, NURSE APPRENTICE LICENSING ACT, by Senator E. J. Vickers, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 12, Lines 366 through 367:
 - 366 (3) An applicant for a registered nurse apprentice license shall:
 - 367 (a) submit to the division an application form prescribed by the division;
- 2. Page 13, Lines 372 through 377:
 - 372 (e) { be enrolled in good standing in the last semester of an approved registered nursing
 - 373 <u>education program;</u> } <u>as determined by an approved registered nursing</u> <u>education program, be:</u>
 - (i) in good standing with the program; and
 - (ii) in the last semester, quarter, or competency experience;
 - 374 (f) have written permission from the program in which the applicant is enrolled;
 - 375 (g) be a legal resident of Utah; and
 - 376 (h) (g) meet with the board, if requested, to determine the applicant's qualifications for
 - 377 licensure.
