Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 101, NURSE APPRENTICE LICENSING ACT**, by Senator E. J. Vickers, with the following amendments:

1. Page 12, Lines 366 through 367:

366 (3) An applicant for a registered nurse apprentice license shall:
367 (a) submit to the division an application form prescribed by the division;

2. Page 13, Lines 372 through 377:

372 (e) ~~{ be enrolled in good standing in the last semester of an approved~~
~~registered nursing~~
373 ~~education program; }~~ as determined by an approved registered nursing
education program, be:
(i) in good standing with the program; and
(ii) in the last semester, quarter, or competency experience;
374 (f) have written permission from the program in which the applicant is enrolled;
and
375 ~~{ (g) be a legal resident of Utah; and~~
376 ~~(h) }~~ (g) meet with the board, if requested, to determine the applicant's
qualifications for
377 licensure.
