The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 104**, COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER CERTIFICATION PROCESS, by Senator L. Escamilla, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 36 through 44:*

- 36 (2) "Community health worker" means an individual who:
37 (a) works to improve a social determinant of health;
38 (b) acts as an intermediary between a {~~specific~~} community and health
 services or social
39 services to:
40 (i) facilitate access to services; or
41 (ii) improve the quality and cultural competence of service delivery; and
42 (c) increases health knowledge and self-sufficiency of an individual or a {
 specific} .
43 community through outreach, capacity building, community education, informal
 counseling,
44 social support, {~~advocacy~~} , and other similar activities ;

2. *Page 2, Lines 45 through 54:*

- 45 (3) "Core-skill education" means education regarding each of the following:
