Mr. Speaker,

The Revenue and Taxation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 125**, HOSPITALITY EMPLOYEE GRANT PROGRAM, by Senator W. A. Harper, with the following amendments, and, due to fiscal impact, recommends it be referred to the Rules Committee for prioritization.

- 1. Page 3, Line 87 through Page 4, Line 92:
 - 87 <u>submit to the office</u> {: <u>88 (i)</u>} <u>a list that includes the name and identifying information for each eligible hospitality</u>
 - 89 employee to whom the eligible hospitality business issued an employer certification {
 - 90 {<u>-(ii) a document that expressly directs and authorizes the State Tax</u> Commission to
 - 91 <u>disclose to the office the eligible small business's returns and other information that</u> would
 - 92 <u>otherwise be subject to confidentiality under Section 59-1-403.</u> }
