VACCINE PASSPORT AMENDMENTS

Representative **Walt Brooks** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 4, Lines 108a through 114:*

108a (g) a federal contractor; ~~{or}~~ ←H
109 H→ [(g)] (h) ←H a governmental entity ~~{, as defined in Section 63D-2-102,}~~ with respect to an
110 employee of the governmental entity if:
111 (i) (A) the employee has, as part of the employee's duties, direct exposure to human blood,
112 human fecal matter, or other potentially infectious materials that may expose the employee
to ~~{:~~ hepatitis or tuberculosis; or
{113 ~~(A) hepatitis; or~~
114 ~~(B) tuberculosis; and}~~
(B) the employee is acting in a public health or medical setting and required to receive vaccinations in order to perform the employee's assigned duties and responsibilities; and

2. *Page 6, Lines 161 through 161a:*

161 (ii) the contract is not between an employer and the employer's employee; H→ [or
161a (e) a federal contractor; ~~{or}~~ ←H

3. *Page 6, Line 173:*

173 (C) conflict with a sincerely held personal belief of the employee ~~{:~~ ; or
(g) a vaccination requirement by an employer with respect to an employee if the employee's primary duties and responsibilities require that the employee:
(i) enter into a regulated entity in Utah, or a facility in a state or territory of the United States outside of Utah, where vaccination is required under state or federal law to access the facility; or
(ii) travel to a country that requires vaccination as a condition of entry into the country.
