 - (7) (a) A parent may opt the parent's student out of participating in a survey prepared through a participating LEA's online data reporting tool described in this section.
 - (b) An LEA shall provide notice to a parent of:
 - (i) the administration of a survey described in Subsection (7)(a); and
 - (ii) the opportunity to opt out of the survey as described in Subsection (7)(a).
