- 1. Page 2, Line 57 through Page 3, Line 67:
 - 57 (i) The special education student growth factor is calculated by comparing [S-3] total
 - 58 special education [ADM of two years] average daily membership of one year previous to the
 - 59 current year to the [S-3] total special education [ADM three] average daily membership two
 - 60 years previous to the current year, not to exceed the official October total school district {-or
 - 61 <u>charter school</u>} growth factor from the prior year.
 - 62 (ii) When calculating and applying the growth factor, a school district's [S-3] { or charter
 - 63 school's total special education [ADM] average daily membership for a given year is limited to
 - 64 [12.18%] the following percentage of the school district's [S-3] {or charter school's} total student
 - 65 [ADM] average daily membership for the same year[-]:
 - 66 (A) for a school district { or charter school } in a county of the first, second, or third class,
 - 67 <u>14%; and</u>
