Representative Karen Kwan proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 8 through 10:
 - 8 General Description:
 - 9 This bill requires a portion of a peace officer's {-annual} basic training to include certain
 - 10 subjects involving victim targeting.
- 2. Page 1, Lines 12 through 17:
 - This bill:
 - 13 ▶ defines terms;
 - requires <u>under certain conditions</u> a peace officer's {-annual} <u>basic</u> training to include training on identifying,
 - 15 responding to, and reporting a criminal offense that is motivated by certain personal
 - attributes or a violation of federal criminal law concerning hate crimes; and
 - 17 makes technical and conforming changes.
- 3. Page 3, Lines 60 through 64:
 - 60 (6) Beginning July 1, 2022, the director shall __, subject to approval by a majority vote of the council, ensure that {annual} the basic training curriculum covers
 - 61 instruction on identifying, responding to, and reporting a criminal offense that is:
 - 62 (a) motivated by a personal attribute, as that term is defined in Section 76-3-203.14,
 - 63 victim targeting penalty enhancement; or
 - (b) in violation of a federal criminal law concerning hate crimes.
