Representative **Brian S. King** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 4, Lines 100 through 101:
 - 100 (i) using the same or less restrictive financial requirements for mental health and substance use disorder
 - benefits as for medical and surgical benefits; and
- 2. Page 4, Lines 104 through 111:
 - (b) In covering mental health and substance use residential treatment, a health plan
 - offered by an exempt governmental entity may {
 - 106 <u>(i) develop preauthorization and participating provider standards at parity with benefits</u>
 - 107 provided for treatment at skilled nursing facilities;
 - 108 (ii) limit participating provider status for reasons other than to reduce access to covered
 - 109 services at parity with benefits provided for treatment at skilled nursing facilities; and
 - 110 <u>(iii)</u>} refer to the health plan's coverage of skilled nursing facilities for purposes of
 - 111 quantitative and non-quantitative treatment limitation requirements.
- 3. Page 4, Line 113:
 - governmental entity's exempt status under 42 U.S.C. Sec. 300gg-21(a)(2).
 - (d) The provisions of this Subsection (4) apply to a health plan that is entered into or renewed on or after July 1, 2022.
