Representative **Raymond P. Ward** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 44 through 45:*

44 (1) As used in this section, a "qualified IRC 501(c)(3) charitable ~~{-clinic}~~ organization "
means a

50 (b) employs licensed therapy clinicians or social workers ;

52 the state with a spinal cord injury or traumatic brain injury ; and

3. *Page 3, Lines 67 through 71:*

67 (a) assist one or more qualified IRC 501(c)(3) charitable ~~{-clinics}~~ organizations to provide
68 rehabilitation services to individuals who have a traumatic spinal cord or brain injury that tends
69 to be nonprogressive or nondeteriorating, including:
70 (i) physical, occupational, and speech therapy; and
71 (ii) equipment for use in the qualified IRC 501(c)(3) charitable ~~{-clinic}~~ organization ;

4. *Page 4, Line 94:*

94 (b) be used for medical treatment, ~~{-long-term care, or acute care}~~ except for
neuropsychological evaluations .
