- 1. Page 3, Lines 70 through 72d:
 - 70 (5) "Supervision $\hat{S} \rightarrow \underline{standards} \leftarrow \hat{S}$ "means $\hat{S} \rightarrow \underline{[a \text{ supervising anesthesiologist is}]}$
 - 70a immediately available in
 - 71 physical proximity that allows the anesthesiologist to return and re-establish direct contact with
 - 72 <u>the patient to meet the medical needs and address any urgent or emergent clinical problems.</u>]
 - 72a standards that:
 - 72b (a) are established by the division through rule; { and }
 - 72c (b) <u>subject to Subsection (5)(c)</u>, comply with the rules and regulations for anesthesia service reimbursement created by the
 - 72d Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services {-} : and

 (c) include a requirement that an anesthesiologist may not supervise more than three anesthesiologist assistants at any one time.

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
