Representative **Melissa G. Ballard** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Lines 23 through 24:

(b) The division shall issue to an individual licensed as a massage assistant in-training a license for a massage assistant if:

- (i) the individual completes the education and training described in Subsection (4)(a)(iv)(B); and
- (ii) passes the examination described in Subsection (4)(a)(v).

(3) (a) When an individual requests a massage service that will be performed by a massage assistant or a massage assistant in-training, the licensee performing or supervising the massage service shall ensure that the requesting individual is notified that the massage service will be performed by a massage assistant or a massage assistant in-training.

(b) The licensee shall ensure that the requesting individual receives the disclosure described in Subsection (3)(a) before the individual schedules or agrees to the massage service.
