Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section 53G-6-904 is enacted to read:
<u>53G-6-904.</u> Indemnification Enforcement.
(1) The state shall indemnify and hold harmless a person acting under color of state
law to enforce this part for any claims or damages, including court costs and attorney fees, that:
(a) are brought or incurred as a result of an action required of the person under this
part; and
(b) are not covered by the person's insurance policies or by any coverage agreement
issued by the State Risk Management Fund.
(2) An LEA or school within the public education system with a team that competes in
an interscholastic athletic activity is responsible for the enforcement of this part in relation to
the LEA's or school's teams.
Section 2. Appropriation.
The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
2022, and ending June 30, 2023. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for
fiscal year 2023. Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures
Act, the Legislature appropriates the following sums of money from the funds or accounts
indicated for the use and support of the government of the state of Utah.

To Attorney General - Attorney General
From General Fund, One-time 500,000
Schedule of Programs:
<u>Civil</u> <u>500,000</u>
The Legislature intends that appropriations provided under this section be used for the
indemnification described in Section 53G-6-904. Under Section 63J-1-603 appropriations
provided under this section do not lapse at the close of fiscal year 2023. The use of any
nonlapsing funds is limited to the indemnification described in Section 53G-6-904.
Section 3. Effective date.
This bill takes effect on July 1, 2022.
