

(b) three members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives, no more than two of whom may be from the same political party;

(c) the executive director of the department appointed in accordance with Section 26B-1-203, or the executive director's designee;

(d) the director of the Division of Facilities Construction and Management appointed in accordance with Section 63A-5b-302, or the director's designee;

(e) the executive director of the Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice, or the executive director's designee;

(f) the chair of the Utah Substance Use and Mental Health Advisory Council, or the chair's designee;

(g) the superintendent of the state hospital, or the superintendent's designee; and

(h) as appointed by the cochair of the commission;

(i) one individual representing a ~~H→ [local behavioral health authority]~~ **Utah Behavioral Health Committee** ~~←H~~ ; and

(ii) one citizen representative from the local community ~~H→~~ , with lived experience ~~←H~~ .

(3) The president of the Senate shall appoint one of the commission members from the Senate as cochair of the commission, and the speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one of the commission members from the House of Representatives as cochair of the commission.

(4) The president of the Senate may remove a member appointed under Subsection (2)(a), and the speaker of the House of Representatives may remove a member appointed under Subsection (2)(b).

(5) A vacancy of a member appointed under Subsection (2)(a) or (b) shall be filled in the same manner as an appointment of the member whose departure from the commission creates the vacancy.

(6) A commission member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed or qualified.

(7) (a) A majority of the voting commission members constitutes a quorum.

(b) The action of a majority of a quorum constitutes action of the commission.

(8) The commission may adopt bylaws to govern the commission's operations and proceedings.

(9) (a) A commission member who is a legislator shall be paid salary and expenses in accordance with Section 36-2-2 and Legislative Joint Rules, Title 5, Chapter 3, Legislator
