## LONG TITLE

## General Description:

This bill establishes a grant program for summer school days and other educational summer programs.

## Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- establishes a grant program for summer school days and other educational summer programs; and
- requires the State Board of Education to:
- award grants to qualifying local education agencies to meet measurable goals;
and
- make rules regarding the administration and measurement of the grant program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section 53F-5-220 is enacted to read:
53F-5-220. Summer education grants.
(1) Subject to legislative appropriations and Subsection (2), the state board shall award a grant to an LEA to provide additional school days during the summer and other educational summer programs.
(2) To qualify for a grant, an LEA shall submit an application to the state board that includes:

## Section 2. Appropriation.
