(a) bring into the meeting room, or possess while in the meeting room, any of the following:
(i) a sign, poster, banner, or placard;
(ii) glitter or confetti;
(iii) a laser pointer;
(iv) paint;
(v) an open flame;
(vi) an incendiary device;
(vii) a noise maker;
(viii) flammable liquid; or
(ix) any harmful or hazardous substance; or
(b) engage in any of the following while in the meeting room:
(i) commercial solicitation;
(ii) leafletting;
(iii) throwing an item; or
(iv) adhering any item to a furnishing, a wall, or other state property.
