8 **General Description:**

9           This bill amends provisions related to funding for the Utah Marriage Commission.

12           ▶ repeals the sunset date for nonlapsing dedicated credits accrued to the Utah

13 Marriage Commission; and

14           ▶ makes technical and conforming changes.

106 approval from the Board of Tourism Development, is repealed; and

107           (e) Title 63N, Chapter 7, Part 2, Board of Tourism Development, is repealed.
