General Description:

This bill requires consultation with the relevant political subdivision before creating certain state highway special designations.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

► requires consultation with the relevant local highway authority before creating a special designation on a state highway if the state highway is located entirely within the geographic area of a municipality, city, town, or county.

28 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

29 Section 1. Section **72-4-200** is enacted to read:

30 **72-4-200. Special designation of state highways -- Procedure.**

31 (1) The Legislature may provide for and establish a special designation of a state
32 highway.

33 (2) For a special designation of a state highway that is located entirely within the
34 geographic jurisdiction of a municipality, city, town, or county, the Legislature shall consult
35 with the relevant municipality, city, town, or county before establishing the special designation
36 of the state highway.
