10 **General Description:**

11 This bill amends provisions related to funding for the Utah Marriage Commission.

109 approval from the Board of Tourism Development, is repealed; and

110 (e) Title 63N, Chapter 7, Part 2, Board of Tourism Development, is repealed.

112 Economic Opportunity to issue an amount of tax credit certificates only for rural productions,
