REAUTHORIZATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill provides legislative action regarding administrative rules.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

▶ reauthorizes all state agency administrative rules except for the rules specifically listed in this bill.

This bill provides a special effective date.

ENACTS UNCODIFIED MATERIAL

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **Rules reauthorization.**

All rules of Utah state agencies are reauthorized except:

(1) Subsection (2)(c) of R277-552-7, Requests for a New Satellite School for an Approved Charter School;



26 (2) (a) Subsection (3) of R156-60-102, Mental Health Professional Practice Act Rule --
27 Definitions; and

28 (b) Subsection (2) of R156-60-502, Unprofessional Conduct; and

29 (3) (a) Subsection (3) of R156-61-102, Psychologist Licensing Act Rule -- Definitions;

30 and

31 (b) Subsection (23) of R156-61-502, Unprofessional Conduct.

32 **Section 2. Effective date.**

33 If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this bill takes

34 effect:

35 (1) unless the governor vetoes the bill, the later of May 1, 2023, approval by the
36 governor, or, without the governor's approval, the day following the constitutional time limit of
37 Utah Constitution, Article VII, Section 8; or

38 (2) if the governor vetoes the bill and the Legislature overrides the veto, the later of
39 May 1, 2023 or the date of veto override.
