LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill addresses certain emissions.

- ▶ defines terms;
- ▶ requires the Division of Air Quality to conduct an inventory related to reducing certain emissions;
- ▶ requires the division to publish the inventory on the division's website; and
- ▶ requires the division to report on the inventory.

19-2a-107, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:



26 Section 1. Section **19-2a-107** is enacted to read:

27 **19-2a-107. Point source inventory of halogens.**

28 (1) As used in this section:

29 (a) "Applicable geographic area" means the counties in which the division knows
30 halogens are emitted, including:

31 (i) Box Elder County;

32 (ii) Davis County;

33 (iii) Salt Lake County;

34 (iv) Tooele County;

35 (v) Utah County; and

36 (vi) Weber County.

37 (b) "Division" means the Division of Air Quality created in Section [19-1-105](#).

38 (2) By no later than December 31, 2024, the division shall complete an air emissions
39 inventory of point sources in the applicable geographic area that emit halogens.

40 (3) Upon completion, the division shall publish the air emissions inventory on the
41 division's public website.

42 (4) The division shall report to the Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment
43 Interim Committee regarding the status of the air emissions inventory:

44 (a) on or before the 2023 November interim committee meeting of the Natural
45 Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee; and

46 (b) on or before the 2024 November interim committee meeting of the Natural
47 Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee.
