CHAPTER 68. PERMITTED EVENT WITH ADULT THEME NOTIFICATION

29	11-68-101. Definitions.
30	As used in this chapter:
31	(1) "Event permit" means a permit that a public entity issues to the organizer of an
32	event in a public building or on public grounds.
33	(2) (a) "Event with an adult theme" means an event that:
34	(i) contains content that may not be appropriate for children; and
35	(ii) takes place in a public building or on public grounds.
36	(b) "Event with an adult theme" may include an event that contains:
37	(i) nudity;
38	(ii) sexual activity or content; or
39	(iii) excessive profanity.
40	(3) (a) "Public building" means a building or permanent structure that is:
41	(i) owned, leased, or occupied by a public entity or a subunit of a public entity;
42	(ii) open to public access in whole or in part; and
43	(iii) used for public education or public entity activities.
44	(b) "Public building" does not mean a building or permanent structure that is owned or
45	leased by a public entity or a subunit of a public entity:
46	(i) that is closed to public access; or
47	(ii) when the building is used by a person, in whole or in part, for a private function.

57	(1) (a) If a public entity grants an event permit for an event that the public entity
58	determines, in the public entity's discretion, is an event with an adult theme, the public entity

59	shall provide notice of possible adult content to members of the public who may view or
60	otherwise be exposed to the event with an adult theme.
61	(b) The notification described in Subsection (1)(a) shall:
62	(i) be designed to provide a parent or guardian with sufficient notice so that the parent
63	or guardian may choose to prevent the parent's or guardian's child from viewing or otherwise
64	being exposed to the event with an adult theme; and
65	(ii) be posted near all entrances to the event with an adult theme or otherwise be
66	designed to provide adequate notice to members of the public who may view or otherwise be
67	exposed to the event with an adult theme.
68	(2) In making a determination as to whether an event is an event with an adult theme as
69	described in Subsection (1), the public entity shall obtain sufficient information regarding the
70	event in order to be able to make a reasonably informed determination.
71	(3) Nothing in this section affects the issuance of an event permit or requires a public
72	entity to grant an event permit to an event with an adult theme.
